MC Federation affiliated organisers may wish to produce Event Regulations for their specific events. These regulations should give the specific rules for the event in question. The Event Regulations should, where practicable, display the Circuit Certificate and Event Permit numbers.

Below is a suggested section layout for a set of Event Regulations, showing the information that should be contained in each section.

Section 1 – Event Details

1. Name of the Organising club
2. Title of the Event
3. Event Date
4. Venue
5. Permit and Course Certificate numbers (Where practicable)

Section 2 – Officials (with licence numbers where applicable)

1. Clerk of the Course
2. Assistants to the Clerk of the Course
3. Chief Technical Official
4. Timekeeper
5. Chief Marshal
6. Event Secretary (with contact details)

Section 3 – Entries

1. Details of classes and restrictions
2. Closing date for entries
3. Cost of Entry
4. Maximum number of riders per class
5. Details of all awards

Section 4 – Programme

1. Time for Technical Inspection and Sign On
2. Details of practice order and lengths
3. Name of Class, Number of Races, Length of races
4. Qualification requirements for finals etc

Section 5 – General

1. Any details specific to the meeting or venue not mentioned above
